The IMTC Unified Communications Working Group (WG) would like to thank the ITU-T SG16 for requesting our feedback on the proposed deletion of H.282 and its associated transport protocols H.283 and T.136.

After consulting with our members and the relevant IMTC Activity Groups, we don't know about the existence of any implementations using H.282 for FECC or remote device control. We know that, during the numerous interoperability testing events organized by the IMTC over the years, FECC using H.282 has never been tested nor mentioned as a possible alternative to H.281. Therefore, the IMTC has neither concerns nor objections about SG16 starting a procedure to delete H.282, H.283 and T.136.

We are looking forward to continuing our collaboration for multimedia communication standards and interoperability matters.
